APPROVAL OF AGENDA: Motion by Reinhart to approve agenda as presented, Rabe seconded, motion carried.

SECRETARY'S REPORT:

MINUTES OF PREVIOUS MEETING: The minutes of the May 20, 2026 regular meeting were distributed and reviewed. Motion by Rabe to approve minutes, Faas seconded, motion carried.

UPDATES: City of Williamsburg deal all sorted out, but it's somewhat moot since ABC has a new truck that can handle the loads in a manner to route to the REIC. Supervisors approved a motion at July 10 meeting to start the flow control ordinance approval process.

Motion by Fults to allow Chairman to pursue payment to Garrett Dozark for expenses related to services above and beyond normal duties of an REIC Board member, up to \$2500. Second by Reinhart. Motion carries.
